Scholarship Details:

The North Star Community Credit Union scholarships were established in 1980 and have been paid out annually ever since. Scholarships will range from \$500 -\$1000 each and will be awarded to high school seniors in the markets we serve. The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the number of completed applications received.

Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.

Applicant must be enrolled to be a full-time student at the college of his/her choice.

Applicant, or their parent, must be a NSCCU member.

Application Deadline: May 1 of each year.

Scholarship Disbursement: Scholarship funds will be disbursed after the successful completion of the first semester of college. To receive the funds, recipient must notify the credit union after the first semester and provide verification of enrollment if requested (ex: copy of grades, tuition receipt).
